

E-book

An eBook (electronic book) is a book in an electronic format characterized by an emulation mode of the advanced reading and consultation of paper books.

It can be downloaded from the internet and read, with easiness much higher than that of simple text files on desktop personal computer, on laptops or handheld computers on which you installed the appropriate reading program (eBook reader).

Although the features are independent of the type of machine, usability and mobility are significantly different. While a PC with desktop-like you can read a book sitting at desk at home, with a laptop places where you can read vary greatly. Of course the ultimate in flexibility and comfort is achieved with a Pocket PC, Handheld PC that is equipped with a color screen that can hold the equivalent of a few tens of paper books.

The eBook format, compared to the paper book offers considerable advantages to readers, first of all, the price that is significantly lower than that of its paper equivalent. The absence of printing costs and the reduction of distribution costs, the editor makes it possible to correspond to authors rights greater than those publishing hardcopy. The general trend is to lower the price by 20% compared to the traditional book.

With the eBook format you can also:

choose the font size in which to display the text, thus facilitating the reading of the work;

immediately search for words or phrases contained in the work;

included in the text several bookmarks giving you the ability to create a custom index;

incorporate comprehensive dictionaries (currently in English), which automatically log every time you want to check the meaning of a word;

highlight text with the classic colors of highlighters;

insert notes and comments directly in the text, then getting an index of the same;

how to draw or scribble on the text of any book in print.

Dozens of volumes can then find a place in a single laptop or PocketPC (eBook portability). To purchase an eBook does not need to go to the library or wait for delivery by a courier, the entire buying process, in fact, is immaterial and resolves with a few clicks of the mouse.
